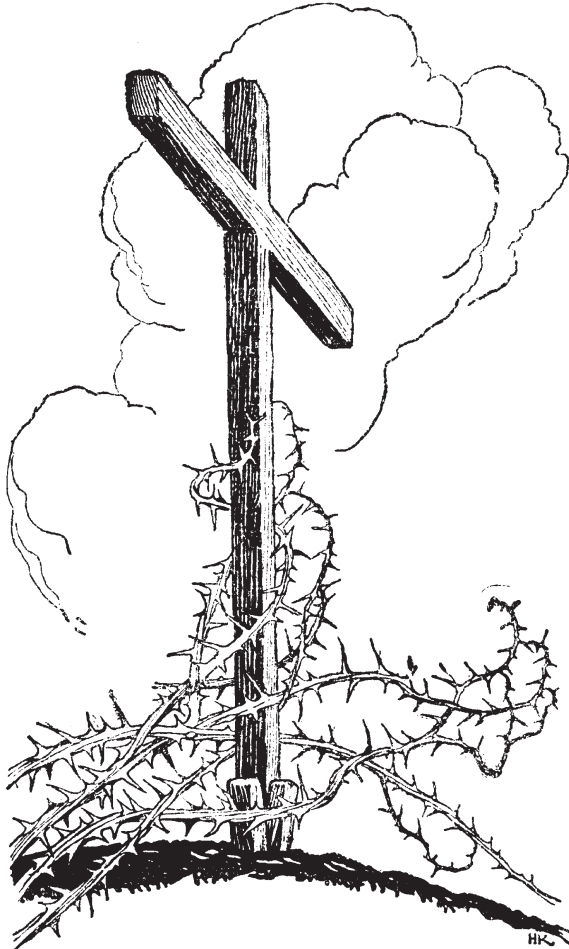

## Events and Opportunities

**Convergence** – Sundays at 9:00 AM. A Sunday morning program which aims to facilitate the coming together of people and seeks to provide opportunities for adult education, spiritual formation and equipping for ministry. Our next term of Convergence starts next Sunday, April 11TH at 9:00 AM with breakfast at 8:45 AM. There are currently 2 classes running:

1. **The Book of Acts** – *with co-facilitators Pauline Pennycad and Nancy Lahn.* This class looks at how God worked in the early church and is active in our lives today.
2. **The Challenge to Love: a Study in 1 Corinthians** – *with co-facilitators Henry and Sharon Tam.* This class examines what Paul says to first century believers in Corinth and how it relates to the church today.

Come and experience learning together in community. Childcare is provided, if needed. Please speak to Carol Smith if your family would like childcare during convergence.

**Praise & Prayer** – Mondays at 7:30 PM. A casual evening of worship and prayer for our church, our community, our country and the world.

**Women's Bible Study** – Tuesdays at 9:30 AM. Fellowship, discussion and prayer.

**Alpha** – Tuesdays from 6:30 – 9:15 PM. A practical introduction to the Christian faith. Each evening includes a meal, video message and small group discussion. Alpha is a place where all questions are welcome.

**Alpha II** – Tuesdays from 6:30 – 9:15 PM. A follow-up course for those wishing to learn more about the Christian faith.

**Children's Ministries** – Children are a significant part of our church family. They work and serve in many areas of church life. Specific programs are provided for them during the Alpha Ministries time, at Club House (Wed. 6:45-8:15 PM, 3 yrs through Gr.6), and at Kids Land (Sun. during the worship time, 0-12 yrs.).

**Club House** – Wednesdays at 6:45 PM. Fun and learning for Preschool to Grade 6.

**Jr. & Sr. Highs** – Wednesdays at 7:30 PM. A fun-filled, spiritual adventure with other young people exploring faith and life together.

**Choir** – Thursdays at 7:30 PM. Fellowship and ministry for those who are musically equipped.

**College & Career** – alternate Saturdays at 7:30 PM. Young adults seeking to encourage and strengthen one another in the journey.

**Small Groups** – throughout the week. Groups choosing intentional community in order to share friendship, grow in their spiritual journeys together, and experience transformation together. Contact one of the pastoral team for more information.

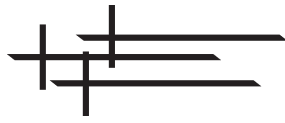
