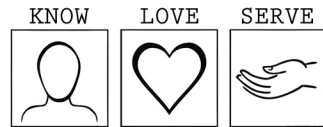


Spotlight

All systems are go with our planned move to Pakistan. Matt is leaving his job at the start of August and we're moving out of our house in Luton at that time too. We're in Canada from August 10TH to September 8TH and plan to study at All Nations Christian College from late September onwards, heading to Pakistan sometime in 2011. This is really exciting and really terrifying – we don't currently have the money to do any of this and we're taking a number of big risks. Please pray that God would provide for our needs and that we would remain in the centre of his will in everything that we do. We're thrilled by the thought of serving him as his ambassadors in Pakistan and daunted by the scale of the challenge. We're encouraged by God's great track record of using small, insignificant people to achieve great things for him! Please pray for us as we step out in faith, and particularly for us as a young family. It's an exciting time!

Congregational Meeting – TONIGHT at 7:00 PM

Join us at 6:30 PM for dessert and coffee/tea. The Congregational Meeting will begin at 7:00 PM. The budget that covers July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011 will be presented for approval. We will also elect Elders. Those being presented as candidates for Elder for the first time will share a brief testimony. Our representatives on the Condominium Board are also elected at this meeting. Your attendance at this meeting is very important. *Copies of the Budget for 2010-2011, pending congregational approval, are ready for pick up today from the Welcome Table in the church foyer.*

Financial Update

As the Board of Elders has identified, we need an additional \$10,000 in General Givings between now and the end of June to cover our 2009/2010 giving deficit. We also anticipate the need to increase our offerings in the 2010/2011 ministry year by approximately \$35,000, and would like to bring those additional givings in by October 31, 2010. This will validate the Congregation's commitment to the increase and prevent cash flow issues throughout the summer months. The Board of Directors and the Board of Elders – who are asking you to meet this challenge – have committed to lead the way by providing \$10K of what is required. To join the Boards in meeting this commitment to raise an additional \$45K between now and October 31ST, please designate your special giving as “2010 Stewardship Challenge” so we know your intentions. May God bless us as we demonstrate our gratitude for His blessings through our tithes and offerings.

You are Invited to a BBQ – NEXT Sunday after Church

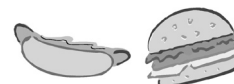
